econometric methods for panel data. With the increasing availability of longitudinal datasets, such

methods are becoming standard and essential tools in applied research. Nonetheless, panel data

econometrics is continuously undergoing theoretical advances and finding new fields of application. The

workshop welcomes the presentation of theoretical and applied papers developing and/or applying micro-

and macro-panel data econometric methods in the form of oral presentations and posters.
