Events for SIdE members



Ninth Italian Congress of Econometrics and Empirical Economics

Because of travel restriction related to the Covid-19 pandemic, the ICEEE 2021 conference will take place online, on the planned dates of January 21-23, 2021.

In case physical attendance in Cagliari will be feasible, any participant may also opt to attend the online conference, as well as the social events, in presence at the conference venue at CRENoS and the Dipartimento di Scienze Economiche e Aziendali, University of Cagliari.

Economists, statisticians and econometricians are invited to submit theoretical and applied papers in all areas of econometrics and empirical economics for presentation at the Congress.

Submission of papers: Papers can be submitted from July 1, 2021 (with a limit of one paper per submitter) at <https://easychair.org/my/conference?conf=iceee20210#>. **The deadline for submission is October 15, 2020. The decision notification date is November 15, 2020.**

Prizes: One prize for the best conference papers written by young scientists in Macroeconometrics or Financial Econometrics (Carlo Giannini Prize, offered by *SIdE*). One prize for the best conference papers written by young scientists in Theoretical or Applied Microeconometrics (Labour Prize, offered by *LABOUR: Review of Labour Economics and Industrial Relations*). For eligibility to both prizes, all authors of a paper must be no more than 4 years past the PhD defense.

Registration Fees:

SIdE members (2021):

SIdE members presenting a paper: 60 EUR (registration deadline December 10th)

Other SIdE members: **free** (registration deadline January 15th)

NON SIdE members:

If presenting a paper: 300 EUR (registration deadline December 10th)

Others: 200 EUR (registration deadline January 15th)

The 10th December deadline is mandatory for a presenter to be included in the scientific program of the conference.

In case physical attendance in Cagliari will be feasible, members who will be willing to participate are very welcome to join. There will be an extra fee of 100 EUR (200 EUR for NON SIdE members) to be paid cash in Cagliari upon arrival at the conference site.

PhD Schools 2020

Because of the pandemic, and the related large uncertainty surrounding the schools and their calendar, the four SIDE 2020 post-graduate courses were delivered both in presence and/or online, depending on the preferences of the candidate participants. Despite it has been the first time in which SIDE delivered synchronous courses in presence and online, the overall **143** participants of which 24 in presence and 119 online, coming from universities and research institutes of different countries all over the world, were surveyed at the end of each course and were very satisfied with this mixed lecturing.

Despite the complicated situation and the uncertainty associated with the COVID-19, the last 3-4 September 2020, the 8th edition of the Workshop in Econometrics and Empirical Economics (WEEE) took place in Bertinoro (Italy). The WEEE has become a classical appointment for PhD students close to the defense of the thesis, but also for those at earlier stages of their research, to present their works in front of a group of senior economists and econometricians, acting as discussants. As usual, each paper had been previously assigned to a discussant who, at the end of the presentation, provided comments and suggestions on the track to follow to publish it in international journals.

We received applications from students coming from universities and research institutes of different countries all over the world, and selected fifteen papers covering many areas of economics and econometrics. Of course, given the difficulties in travelling, we allowed the possibility to mix on site and virtual synchronous presentations and discussions. Clearly, this limited the interconnections between participants, but, in a period where many events have been cancelled or delayed, has represented a useful opportunity for students to share their ideas with colleagues and senior researchers. These are, substantially, the comments we received from them during and after the event. As SidE, our gratitude goes to all discussants that, with their professionalism and enthusiasm, contributed to the success of the event.

Ladislao Mittner 2020 prize in economics

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is pleased to announce the Ladislao Mittner Prize 2020 in the field of Economics. The call is addressed to young scholars and scholars of this field, who work to intensify the Italian-German dialogue in their discipline and have published at least one relevant scientific work with content and/or methodological reference to Germany.

The Award, funded by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF), consists of a sum of 5,000 euro and a DAAD grant for a one-month research stay in Germany, to be used in 2021.

Scholars holding a PhD, with a maximum age of 49 years, and having a research grant or a valid researcher contract at an Italian university are invited to participate.

The *deadline for submission* of applications is September 30, 2020 (12:00 a.m.).
