## ICEEE 2023 – From Lorenzo Trapani

The 10<sup>th</sup> Italian Congress of Econometrics and Empirical Economics (ICEEE 2023) took place at the University of Cagliari between Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May and Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. The conference was held in person at the same university where it had been scheduled for the 2021 edition, which had to be brought online due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The local organizing committee was chaired by Prof Emanuela Marrocu; I should like to thank her, and the committee, for their sterling job which was very much appreciated by all the conference participants.

The Scientific Committee was chaired by me, with the aid of 33 colleagues from various institutions in Italy and abroad. When deciding its membership, I opted for a blend of senior colleagues with past experience with other SIdE events, and more junior colleagues – specifically, 14 colleagues are based abroad, and 8 are at a junior stage of their career. The committee delivered an extremely good performance, helping me select the best papers in a highly competitive field. Thus, I would like to express my gratitude to all my colleagues for their invaluable help, and I would wholeheartedly recommend that mixing senior and junior colleagues should continue as a way of choosing the Scientific Committee.

We had 245 submissions, an unprecedented number. Nevertheless, we decided to not increase the number of parallel sessions compared to the 8<sup>th</sup> ICEEE, thus having 6 parallel sessions. In total, 144 papers were accepted, which corresponds to an acceptance rate slightly below 60%. This meant that several good papers could not be accepted, but on the other hand it enhanced the quality of the conference. In addition, 35 papers were accepted for poster presentation. The conference had three keynote speakers: Prof Anna Simoni (CREST-ENSAE), who presented on “Bayesian Bi-level Sparse Group Regressions for Macroeconomic Forecasting”; Prof Marc Hallin (ULB), who presented on “From copulas and depth to measure transportation: the long quest for multivariate quantiles and ranks”; and Prof Lucio Sarno (Cambridge), who spoke to “Crash Currency Risk Premia”. I would like to thank our keynote speakers, and Prof Monica Billio and Prof Pasquale Della Corte for chairing the plenary sessions. The congress was opened at 13:00 with greetings from the Chair of the Department of Economics (Prof Rinaldo Brau), the Rector of the University of Cagliari (Prof Francesco Mola), the President of SIdE (prof Monica Billio) and myself. The Governor of the Bank of Italy, Prof Ignazio Visco, sent a video recorded message where, as well as offering his wishes to the conference participants, he laid out the future challenges in econometrics and applied economics research from a central bank perspective. The conference opening was also an opportunity to pay tribute to two colleagues who had recently passed away: Prof Stefano Fachin (who was also a member of the Scientific Committee) and Prof Alessandro Sembenelli (former SIdE President, 2011); we wish to thank Prof Gianluca Cubadda and Prof Erich Battistin (whose letter was read by Prof Luca Fanelli), respectively, for their speeches about these highly esteemed and sorely missed colleagues.
